Dear Parent/Carers

Reception Year visit to Mead Open Farm

In support of our class Topic 'Let's Explore', we have arranged a visit to Mead Open Farm in the Spring term. During the visit the children will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities, including feeding the animals and petting the rabbits. The visit will take place on **Thursday 27th March 2025**.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 9.15am and we will return to school by the end of the school day, traffic permitting. The children should wear their normal school uniform and will need suitable outdoor clothing appropriate for the weather on the day and a comfortable pair of shoes.

As we are away from school over the lunch period your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day and bottles of drink (these must not be fizzy drinks). Please send your child's lunch in a backpack so they can comfortably walk around with it on their back. This is to avoid unnecessary use of plastic carrier bags in line with our ethos of being environmentally conscious. **If you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this visit it must be ordered in advance by emailing your child's class teacher. They will then be able to collect it from the school kitchen on the day of the trip.**

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£24** per child towards the cost of the visit. We regret that we may be obliged to cancel this visit if we do not receive sufficient financial support. Payments can be made in instalments via ParentPay. **£12** will be due by **20th February** and **£12** due by **21st March**. You will also be asked to tick the box on ParentPay to give your consent for your child to go on this trip. Before giving your consent it is important that you understand that,

1. While the supervisory adults in charge of the group will take all reasonable care of the young person, neither they, nor the Academy, can necessarily be held liable in respect of loss of or damage to the property or injury suffered by the young person arising out of the educational visit/journey, unless such loss, damage or injury results from the negligence of Goldington Green Academy, its employees or official volunteers, and
2. That you read and understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.
