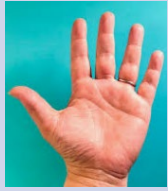

Key Vocabulary and Definition

Poverty	The state of being extremely poor.
Poor	without money, possessions, or other basic needs
Ghana	A place in Africa
Money	People use money to buy things.
Touch	to put one's hand or fingers on in order to feel
Safe	providing protection from harm, loss, or danger
Unsafe	not protected from danger, harm, or loss
Appropriate	right for a certain time and place
Inappropriate	not right or proper for the time or place
Trusted adult	people whose words and actions make you feel safe
Care	showing kindness to those around you
Steal	to take from another without permission or right
Thief	one that steals
Borrow	to take with the promise to return or replace
Angry	feeling or showing anger
Mistrust	lack of confidence or trust
Sadness	the state or quality of being unhappy
loss	the fact that you no longer have something or have less of something
