


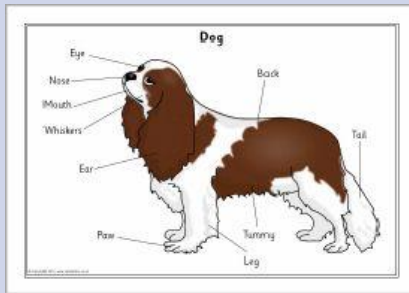


Success Criteria

Why are we learning this?

Non-chronological reports give facts about things.

Why is it important?

People can read the facts to learn about that topic.

Present tense





The present tense means you write as if something is happening now.
e.g. The tiger is black and orange.



A fact is something which is true.
