### Key Vocabulary

Facts	Sentences that are true.
Present tense	Write as if it is happening now e.g. The tiger is black and orange.
Third person	Write about other people and things. Don't use 'I'.
Expanded noun phrases	A phrase made up of a noun and at least one adjective e.g. the enormous grey elephant.
