


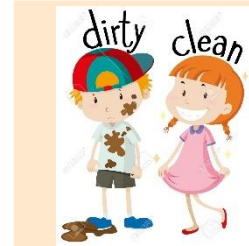


Success Criteria

Adjective



An adjective describes a noun.
e.g. The tiger is **black** and **orange**.
