Dear Parents/Carers,

YEAR 2 VISIT TO WARWICK CASTLE – Wednesday 20th November 2024

As part of our topic 'Turrets and Trebuchets' we would like to take our Year Two children to Warwick Castle. The visit will allow the children to experience a castle first-hand and learn more about them in an interactive way.

This visit will take place on **Wednesday 20th November 2024** and the children will travel by coach. We will leave school after morning registration and return to school by **4:00pm**. Please collect your child from the **school car park gate**. The children should wear their normal school uniform, sensible shoes and a weatherproof coat.

As we are away from school over the lunch period, your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day. **If you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this visit; it must be ordered in advance by emailing your child's class teacher.** If your child is bringing their own lunch please send it in a backpack so they can comfortably walk around with it on their back. This is to avoid unnecessary use of plastic carrier bags in line with our ethos of being environmentally conscious. We will encourage the children to refill their water bottles.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£25** per child towards the cost of the visit. We regret that we may be obliged to cancel this visit if we do not receive sufficient financial support. **Please make your payment via ParentPay no later than Friday 15th November 2024.** You will also be asked to tick the box on ParentPay to give your consent for your child to go on this trip. It is essential that you tick this.

Before giving your consent, it is important that you understand that,

1. While the supervisory adults in charge of the group will take all reasonable care of the young person, neither they, nor the Academy, can necessarily be held liable in respect of loss of or damage to the property or injury suffered by the young person arising out of the educational visit/journey, unless such loss, damage or injury results from the negligence of Goldington Green Academy, its employees or official volunteers, and
2. That you read and understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided.
