Use pronouns and nouns to aid cohesion and avoid repetition

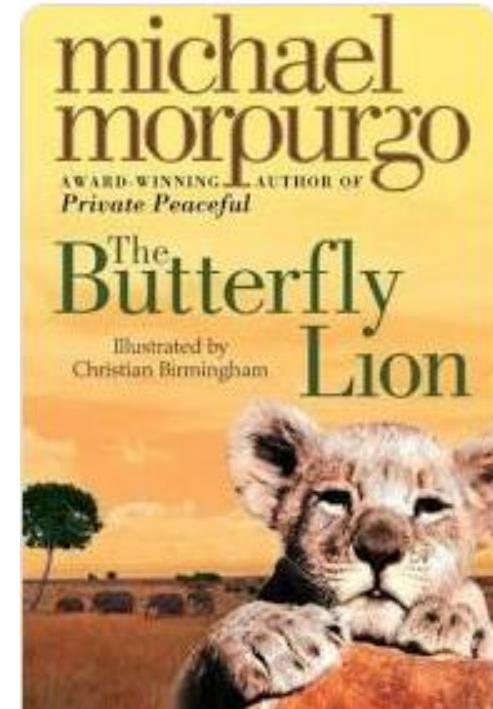
Use a range of adverbs to add detail to writing
