A character is a person in a story.

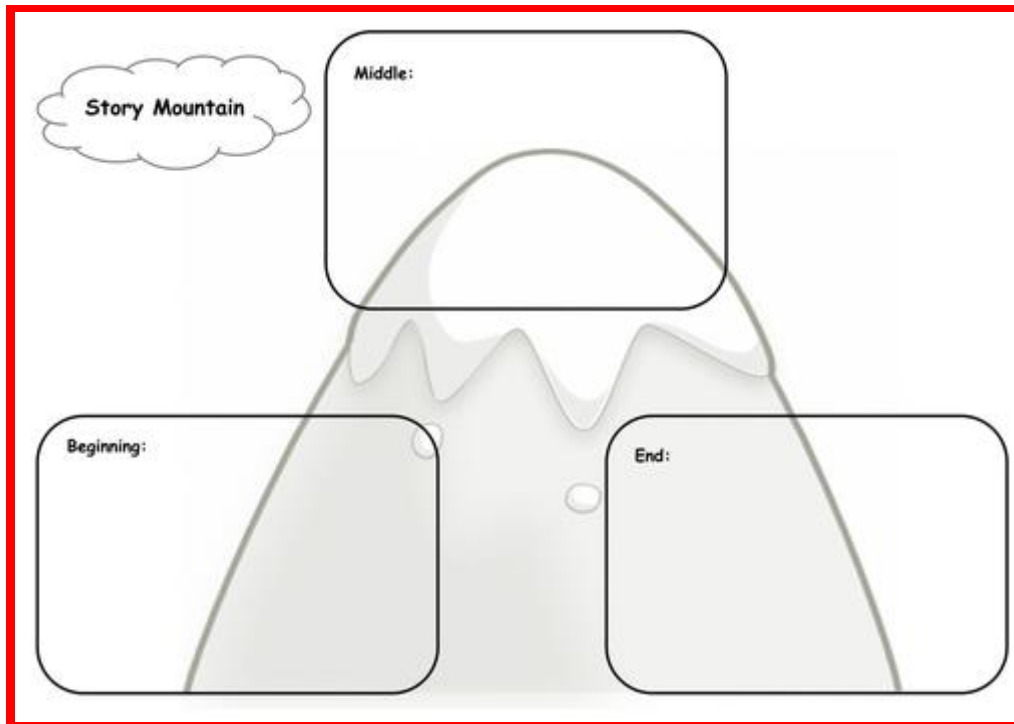


Why are we learning this?
