Time connectives	
first	next
then	finally

Past tense	First person
<p>The past tense means you write about things that have already happened. e.g. I went to the park.</p> 	<p>Use words like 'I', 'me' and 'my'.</p> 

Why are we learning this?	Why is it important?
<p>Recounts are written reports of what we have done.</p>	<p>Recounts tell other people what we have done.</p>
