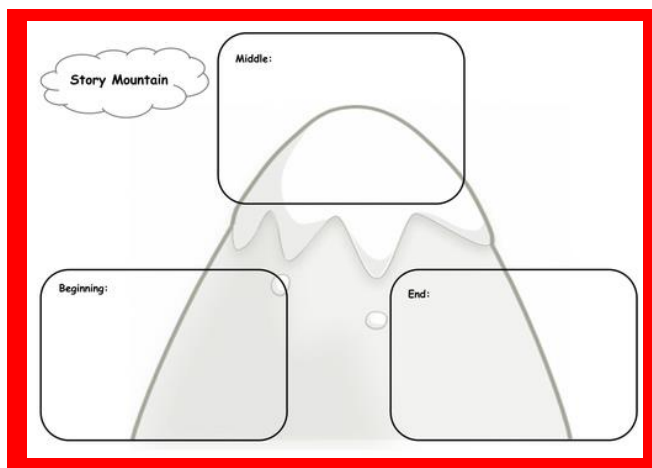
Traditional language
