

# GGA- Year 4 Geography Egypt-Spring Term

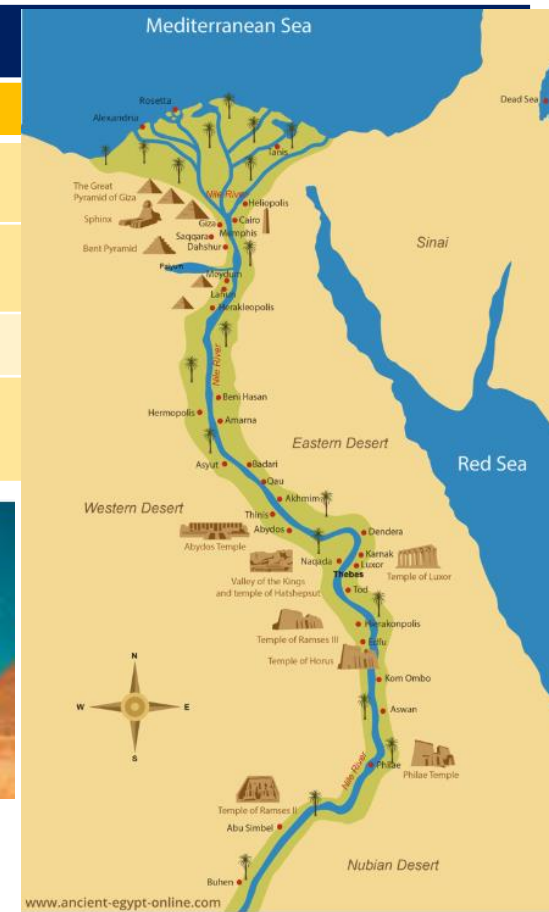
## Key Vocabulary and definition

**Egypt** is in the **African** continent. Capital City is **Cairo**. Touristic features e.g. Pyramids, Valley of the Kings

Physical features: **Nile River**, **Red Sea**, **Mediterranean Sea**, **Sahara desert**, Lake Nasser, Suez canal

Major cities: Alexandria, Luxor, Memphis, Giza

**Nile delta** Where the Nile river splits into smaller distributaries and irrigates/waters the fan shaped landscape- making fertile soils for growing crops
